

NARRATIVE BALANCE Debate Split



61% means most tracked mentions frame the day as momentum-positive (cadence, readiness confidence, demand). 39% means a significant minority is focused on execution risk (repairs, slips, policy friction). This matters because shifts in this split usually lead tomorrow's headlines and attention.
